Old Business:

- April minutes approved.
- **Mailbox Matching Funds** – Jon will look into status with City of Bellevue. Other than receiving funds, mailbox upgrade is complete.
- **Entry Island Upgrade** – Sites surveyed by City of Bellevue (Patricia/Scott). Approval for matching funds up to \$4,000.
 - o City of Bellevue can get plants at cost
 - o Need 2' in from each curb.
 - Will need to resize boulders on drawings.
 - o Plant in fall
 - o Fence on Collingwood II entrance. City of Bellevue (Ron) waiting on proposed ideas to replace the fence.
 - Project 100% paid by City of Bellevue.
 - Separate project to get ideas/approval for fence replacement.
 - Schedule meeting to propose Board ideas to neighborhood.

 - Maybe post hole in ground to support "event" sign.
